This month, we will begin to review all the letters and the numbers 0-10. We will switch from Discovering our World to Discovering our Land. We will talk about mountains, hills, valleys and islands. Our Science curriculum will cover Frozen Water, Hibernation/Migration, Weird Weather and All Kinds of Animals. The themes of the month will be Wild Winter, Zany Circus, Zoo Crew and My Favorite Pet. We will finish up the Fruit of the Spirit and learn about some other character traits that we need to know. We will be having Vision Screening on January 6, 7 and 8.
