



Welcome to the Loveable Lambs Class. I am so excited to get the school year started.

For the month of August, we will be going over the rules (the children get to tell me what the rules should be for our classroom, playground and hallway). We will also be learning why we are all so special and unique. We will talk about Creation and Adam and Eve. I am introducing the children to the Westward Movement on a level they can understand. This should prove to be a fun time. In Science, we will talk about our bodies and our five senses. We will work on writing our names and learning the letter Aa and the numbers 0, 1, and 2.

For the month of September, we will talk about Fantasy and Fairy Tales, Knights and Castles, Fabulous Fall and Music and Melodies. For Science, we will learn about Trees, Seeds and Pinecones, Leaves and Bark, and Owls. I am trying to stick to a nature based science theme this year with at least one animal a month. For Social Studies, we will talk about and do art projects and sample food that are related to moving west across our country. We will also be covering Noah's Ark, the Tower of Babel, Joseph and Abraham this month. We will be learning about the letters Bb through Ee and the numbers 3-6, as well as sorting and sequencing.

I will be asking the children to use the Computer and Listening Center at least once a week (more if they choose to), and access the Math and Writing Centers at least twice a week. We will also be having a music class every Thursday with the Choir Director from the church. Our Chapel has been changed to Fridays.

We start our Circle time at 9:00. Please be sure your child is here no later than 9. We cover so much during this time. I don't want them to miss out on anything. If your child is part time, please don't pick them up before 2:55. We will be doing projects every afternoon and I would like all the children to be able to participate. As the weather gets colder, please be sure to send a jacket along with your child and check their emergency clothing to see if they still fit and are seasonally appropriate.

The school will be closed August 23 for Teacher's Work Day and September 6 for Labor Day. Back to School Night is September 22 and Fall Pictures are on September 30 and October 1.

During the first few weeks, I will be observing the children to see where they are academically and I will adjust the class to fit their needs. Each child will be taught at his/her own level. If I need to speed up, I will. If I need to slow down, I will do that too.
